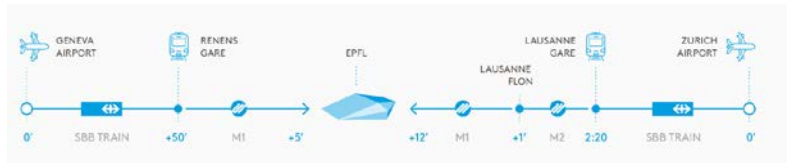
Cancellation & refund
