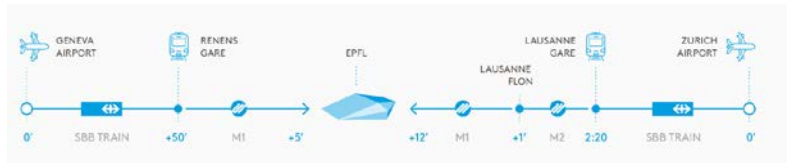
## **Cancellation & refund**

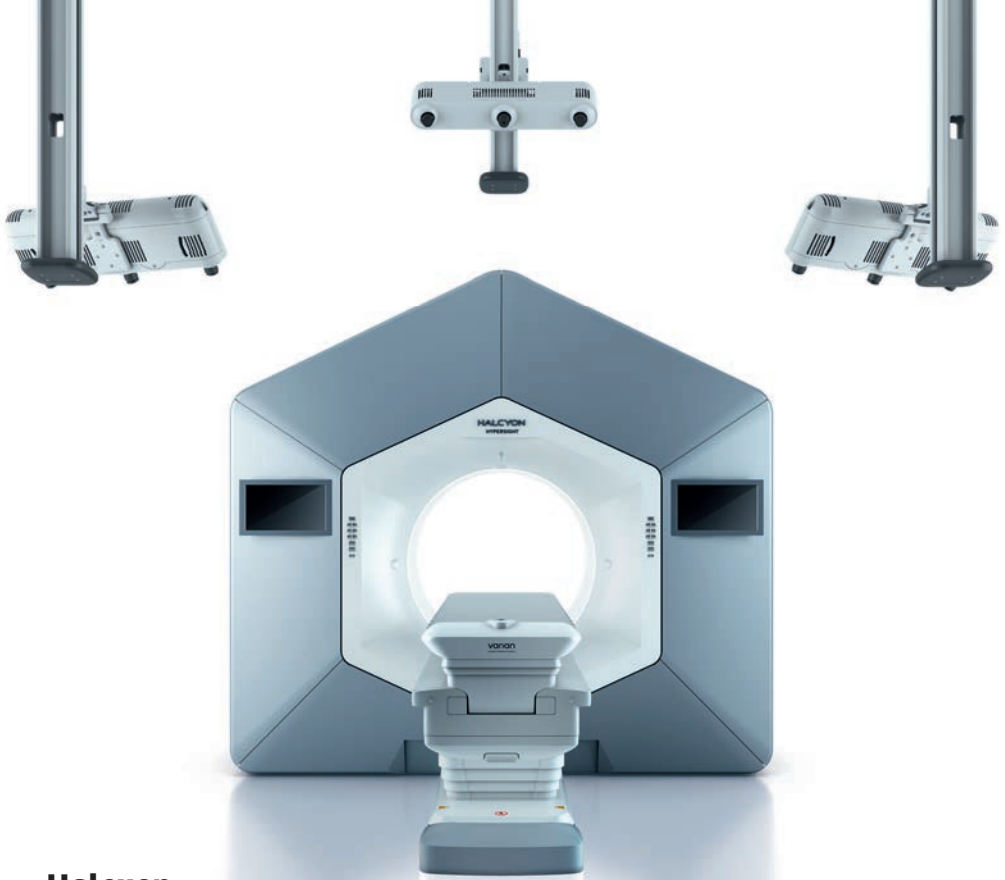
