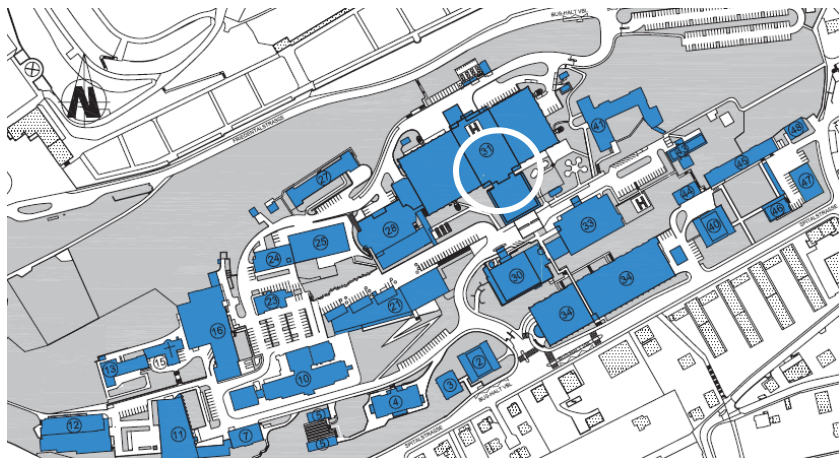


How to find the meeting site

By car: A2/A4 exit Emmen-Süd

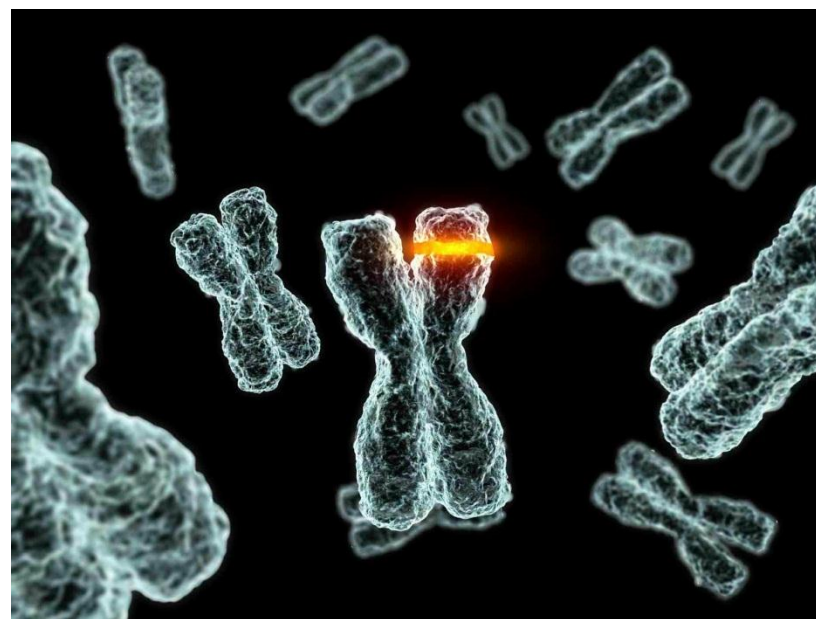
